

Poster announcing military evacuation of Japanese-Americans, 1942

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From LoC: "Civilian exclusion order #5, posted at First and Front streets, directing removal by April 7 of persons of Japanese ancestry, from the first San Francisco section to be affected by evacuation."

This poster was displayed in San Francisco in April 1942 to inform Japanese-Americans that they would be evacuated from the area by the U.S. military.
