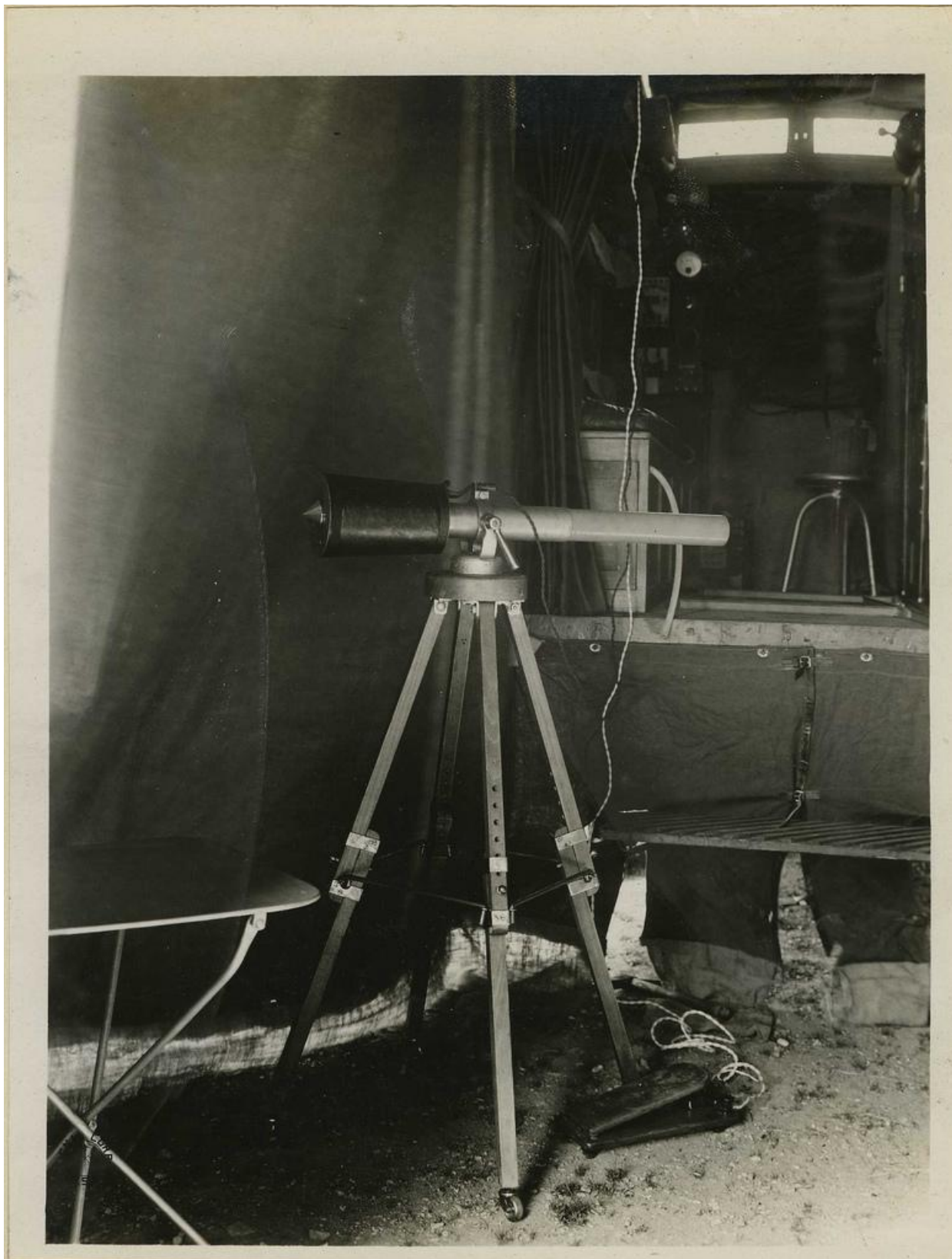


Surgical electric magnet
