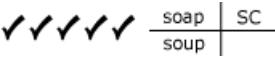


## Running record: Self-correction

### Running record: Self-correction

When a student reads a word incorrectly and then immediately corrects the mistake, the behavior is noted in a four-square grid: at left, the spoken word is written above the expected word, and then in the upper right square, the letters SC are written.
