an optically-formed duplicate or representative reproduction of an object. An image is created by manipulating light using mirrors, lenses, or pinholes, so that the light entering an observer's eye or hitting a screen appears to be originating from a copy of the object, often displaced from its true position and altered in size (magnified) or orientation (inverted).
