This is an image of an excerpt from the original publication of the *Boston-Gazette*, and *Country Journal*, July 15, 1771. The paper published an account of the prosecution and execution of Regulators after their defeat at the Battle of Alamance on May 16, 1771. This paper is in the collections of the Massachusetts Historical Society.

NEWBERN, (North-Carolina) June 7. Since our last, the Hon. SAMUEL CORNELL, Esq; returned home from our Troops in Orange County, and brings a certain Account of the Regulators being entirely broken and dispersed, and that near 13 or 1400 of them have laid down their Arms, taken the Oaths of Allegiance to his Majesty, and returned to their Habitations in His Excellency the Governor, after the Battle. marched into the Plantations of Husbands, Hunter, and feveral others of the outlawed Chiefs of the Regulators, and laid them waste; they having most of them escaped from the Battle, and are fince fled. A Reward of 1000 Acres of Land, and 100 Dollars, is offered by his Excellency for Husbands, Hunter, Butler, and Rednap Howell,(1) and several of the Regulators have been permitted to go in Quest of them, on leaving their Children Hostages. Q
The Lands of the outlawed Regulators are
to be fold by the Sheriff of the County where they lie, agreeable to Act of Assembly; and many of them are of great Value, being perhaps the best Lands on this Continent, particularly Hermon
